This letter is to introduce Vincent Graceffo. Vincent, a Canadian national holding passport number AP221770, has been employed aboard Jamaica Bay, of Cayman Island registry, for the past few months.

Vincent was hired originally in a day work capacity, but has proven to be invaluable in all aspects of the operation of this vessel.
