Re: Service on M/Y Braveheart

Vincent Graceffo was the Captain of M/Y Braveheart, a 1989 Swedeship Tri-Deck Jet Drive Powerboat, from June 2007 until Feb 2008.

Braveheart cruised the Eastern Seaboard for 2 months, then entered into a shipyard period from Sep 1 2007 thru January 2008. During that period Vincent was responsible for the complete supervision of major refit items, including new teak deck, generator overhauls, painting waterline up, steel structural work on swim platform, refit of the bridge electronics to the digital age, and items too numerous to mention of routine maintenance.

Vincent supervised the work of the crew, the yard, and many outside contractors and day workers. He completed the work efficiently in terms of cost and schedule which saved the vessel considerable money both in budget, and avoiding overruns. We used no outside management support staff in the refit, so this was all his to manage.

Vincent is a highly competent seaman, handled the boat very well, and the logistics of the trips with no difficulties.
